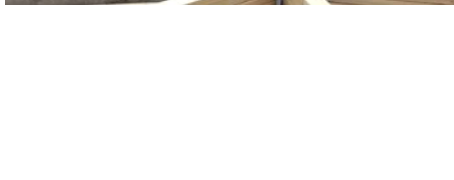
▶ 2007 marks the 20th year of

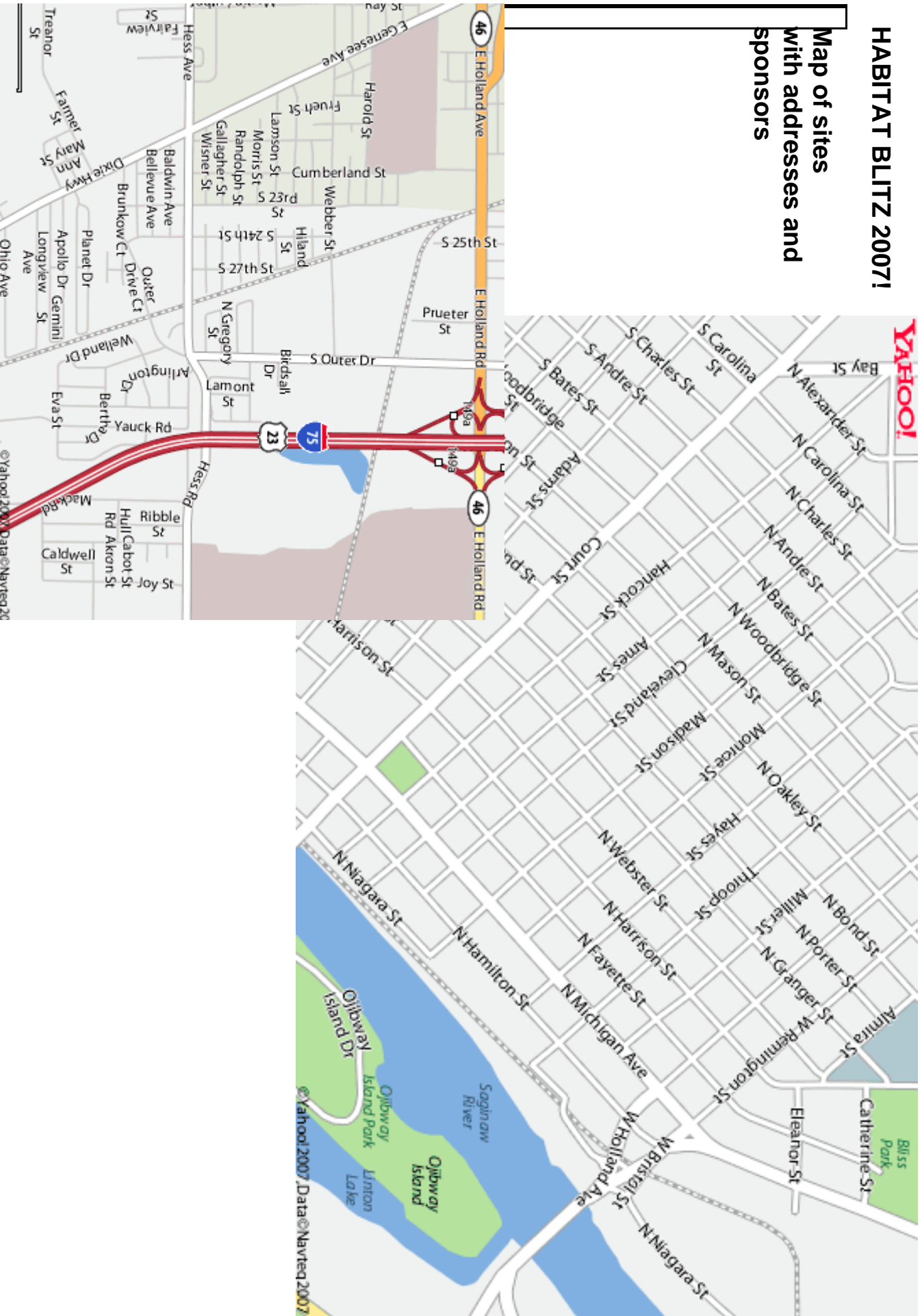
