**Hemlock Semiconductor Corporation to Build Habitat House**

Hemlock Semiconductor Corporation (HSC) volunteers, in partnership with Saginaw Habitat for Humanity (SHFH) will build its first Habitat house in Saginaw County during a three-week blitz build, beginning September 26. The three-bedroom house, 1801 S. Niagara (corner of McGregor) is funded by donations from the Saginaw community. The floor deck will be constructed on Saturday September 24.

Paul Warriner, Executive Director of Saginaw Habitat for Humanity noted, "We welcome the opportunity to work with Hemlock Semiconductor Corporation. Their offer to help came along at the right time, since we have a special needs family that we would like to have in this home before the end of the year. We are looking forward to a fruitful partnership with HSC and its employees. I am hopeful they will catch the Habitat bug."

This is the first three-week schedule for a build in Saginaw County. HSC volunteers will work Monday through Friday with professional tradesmen completing their work during the second week.

Gregory Skufca, Site Manager for HSC, stated, "This is a positive partnership with Saginaw Habitat for Humanity. Our employees, retirees and family members are excited to have this opportunity to give back to the community."

The Arnold Center's Currie Café will be providing lunches and beverages each day. The Arnold Center is a community rehabilitation organization that provides vocational training and employment opportunities for people with disabilities and other barriers to community inclusion.

Habitat for Humanity International (HFHI) is a non-profit, ecumenical Christian housing ministry dedicated to eliminating poverty housing and homelessness. HFHI has built over 200,000 houses in its 30-year history. Saginaw Habitat for Humanity has built or renovated 127 houses since its founding in 1987. Donations are tax-deductible.
